From the ePaper directly into the press review

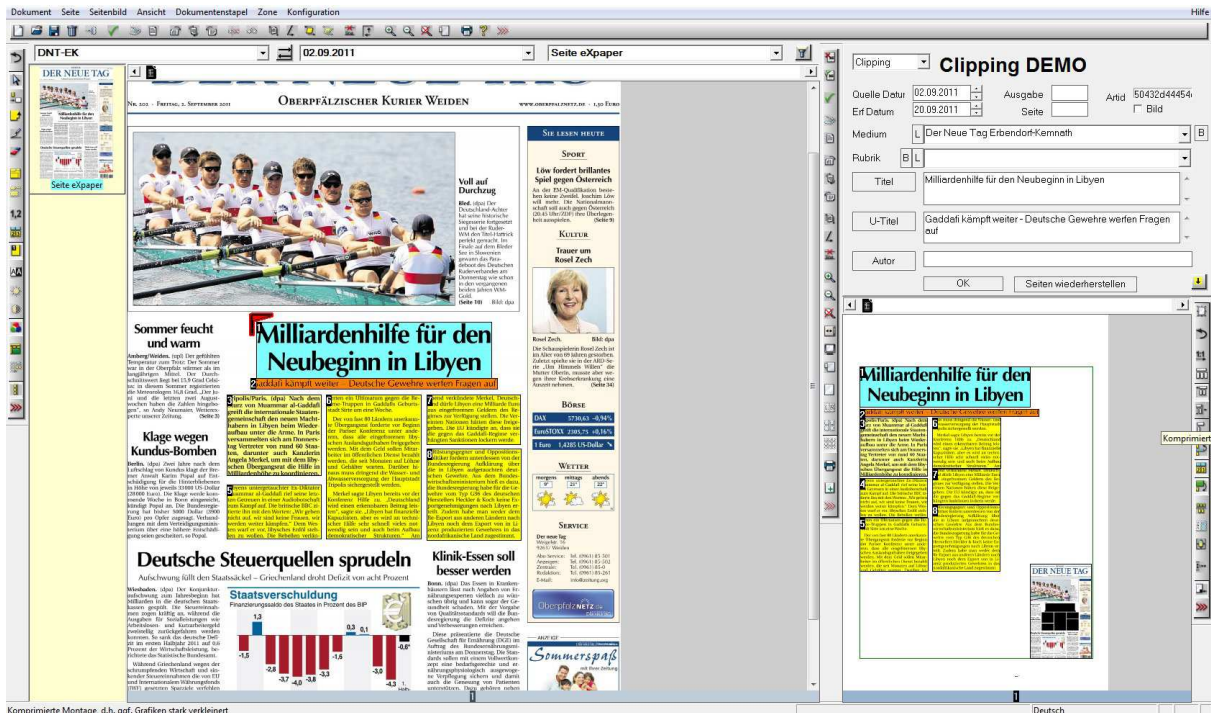
With a newspaper subscription many publishers offer the access to the daily ePaper editions on their website.

You download the PDFs and easily search them right away - also several sources simultaneously. Full text searching with any terms you choose: names, keywords...

With just one click all relevant articles and pages are highlighted. Like in the print edition, you have a full view of the framework and the original layout.

After taking over the complete newspaper pages into the clipping module **newsCLIP**, the previously marked articles will be wrapped to A4 size in a way that all relevant layout features are maintained. In addition, a miniature version shows the article position on the original page. Finally your press review will be produced with **newsWEB** - as usual in excellent quality – enriched by the articles from the newspapers' ePaper editions.
