



The option **newsWEB fulltext** provides the user of the **newsWEB 6.5** press editorial software with the opportunity to use the full text to find already stored press articles. Therewith **newsWEB** is no longer just used as a database for the production of current press reviews, but also as press archive.

As the search uses specialized search algorithms it offers the great advantage of being able to start qualified search queries in order to quickly find the right articles as hits. From this selection you can immediately produce theme dossiers, special editions and weekly compilations - with automatically created, flexibly layoutable cover page and table of contents.

For this purpose, the user is provided with the Lucene full-text engine, which – amongst others – supports the following search options:

- Search in fulltext, in fields and/or date ranges
- Boolean links and/or/not
- truncation parameters ? * (e.g. eco?omy, country*)
- Proximity operators
- Bracket terms, query search
- Search for words composed of several words
- Fuzzy Search
- Search in fields
- Search in date ranges
- Combined query of field contents and full text
- Hit list sorted by date, source, title, rubric
- Indexing automatically on import
- Search in digital (Internet, PMG) and clipped (e-paper, scan) article inventories
- Hit marking in the digital article text and on the facsimile

The articles are displayed as a search result in the article table and can be used immediately to create press reviews, weekly or monthly editions and/or dossiers. However, to search scanned and clipped articles, the full-text recognition option **DataScan.OCRImportService** is required additionally.
